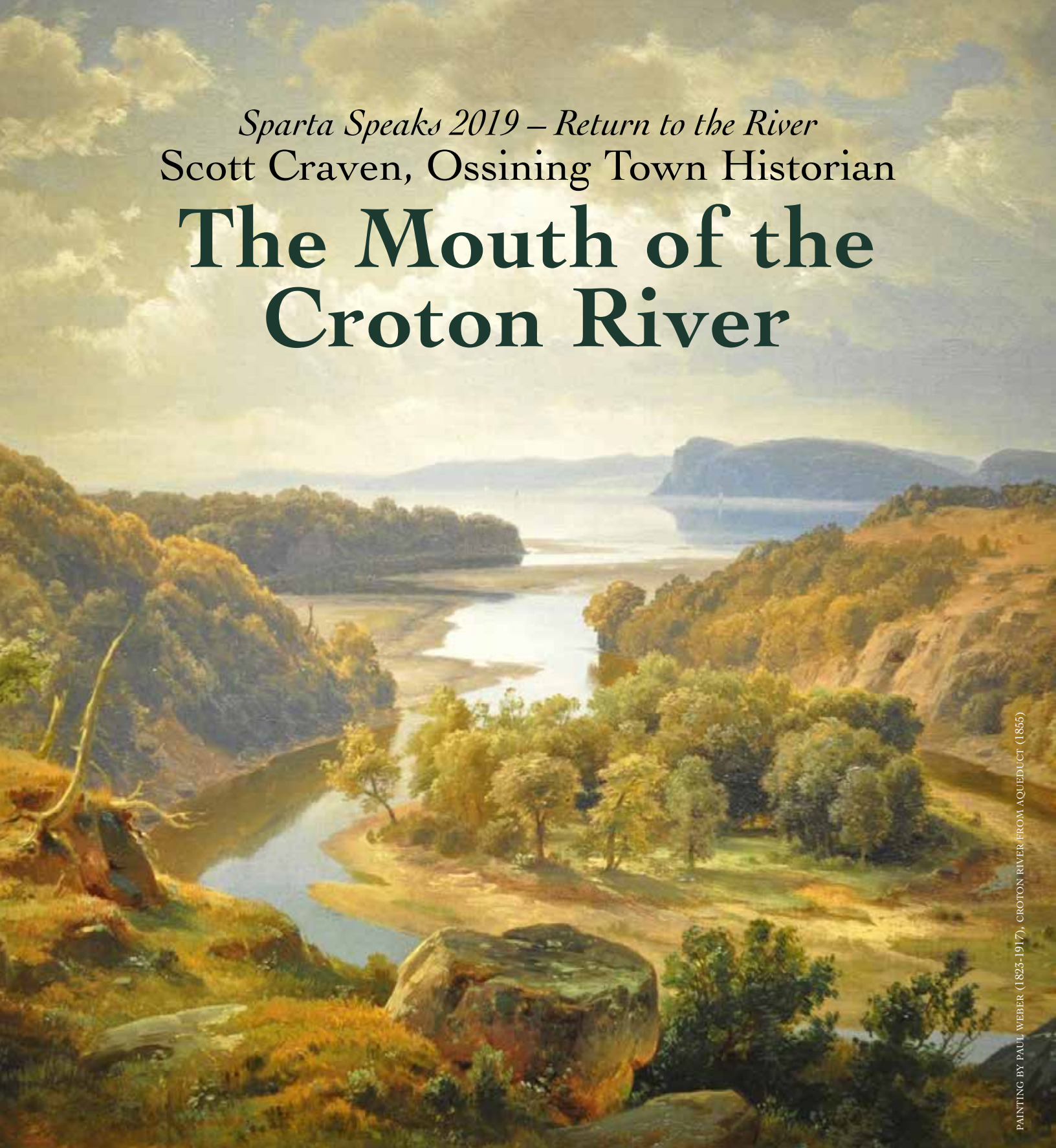

Please join us for the 2019 Annual Meeting of The Jug Tavern of Sparta. Our guest speaker will be **Scott Craven**, Ossining Town Historian. Scott's specialty is environmental history. He tells us, "Every major historical and natural theme that makes the Hudson Valley so interesting can be found at the mouth of the Croton River. It is the best place to experience the whole valley." He will talk about the American Revolution, the glacial origins of the landscape, the area's different inhabitants, including the Lenape, the Dutch, and various species of birds. Scott invites us to

look with a fresh perspective on the place where the Croton meets the Hudson.

Scott has lived his whole life on the banks of the Hudson River, where he swims, paddles, boats, and fishes between Piermont and Bannerman's Castle. He has a Masters in history from Western Connecticut University and served 32 years with the Ossining Police Department. He recently retired the department as captain, and now works at the Ossining Public Library. Scott loves talking to people about the River. This is an event not to be missed!
